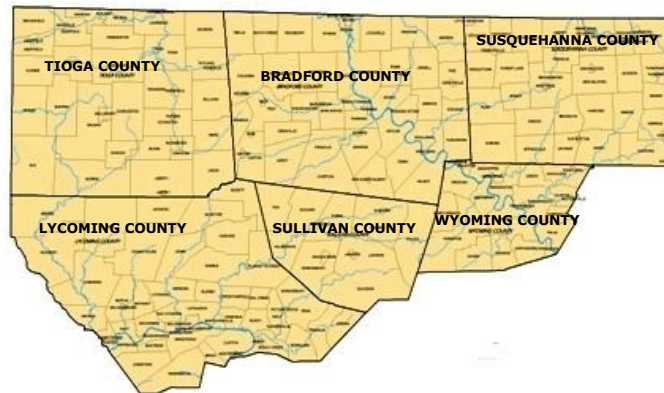

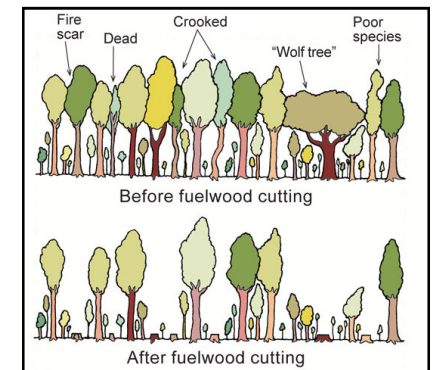

Endless Mountains RC&D Biomass Program Information Sheet

2016 Biomass Cost Share:

Over 8 Billion gallons of oil per year is used for space heating.

Some of this could be replaced with a local renewable fuel.

EMRC&D is pursuing a program to promote the use of biomass heating systems within their

respective counties. This effort is considered to be fully consistent with promoting the wise use of our natural resources.



Objective: To offset the use of some fossil fuels (oil, propane,

coal) used for space heating through the use of biomass fuels (cordwood or pellets).

Benefits of wood:

- It's a renewable/ sustainable fuel
- More environmentally friendly than fossil fuels
- Creates a market for low grade wood
- Financial benefits to the local area and user

Disadvantages of wood:

- Requires more participation from the user than fossil fuels
- Requires a monetary expenditure to get started

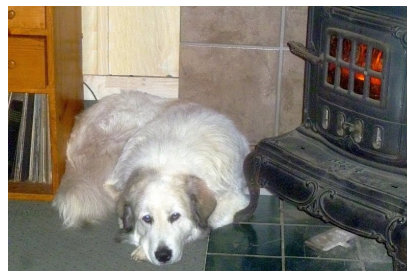
With the belief that the advantages of using wood outweigh the disadvantages for some residents within our counties, this program will share information with interested residents and assist them in pursuing a wood option if they choose to do so. It is not for everybody.

The 2016 program offers a cash incentive for individuals interested in a wood heating unit to replace current use of oil, coal, or propane heating fuel.

\$500 cost share toward the purchase of a new EPA certified cordwood or pellet stove.

Limited funds are available for residents of Bradford, Sullivan, Susquehanna, and Lycoming counties. Low income households will have priority for these incentives until Oct 15th, 2016.

The homeowner will be responsible for costs associated with chimney and installation requirements.
